Codes of Conduct for Parents / Carers

Remember that children play for their fun, not yours.

Encourage your child always to play by rules and to respect the instructors, officials and volunteer.

Encourage children to play, do not force them.

Praise your child's efforts whether they win or lose.

Applaud all good play.

Never ridicule a child for losing or making a mistake.

Children learn best by following a good example.

Learn the rules to better understand what you are looking at and commenting on.

Instructor's decision should never be questioned.

If any problems / questions / concerns discuss it with the instructors and not other parents.

Do not question the judgement of and show your appreciation to all officials, instructors and helpers.

Condemn the use of violence, profane language and any form of abuse. Think of how you can best help the instructors and / or the club.

As a spectator you must never enter the field of play / activity.
